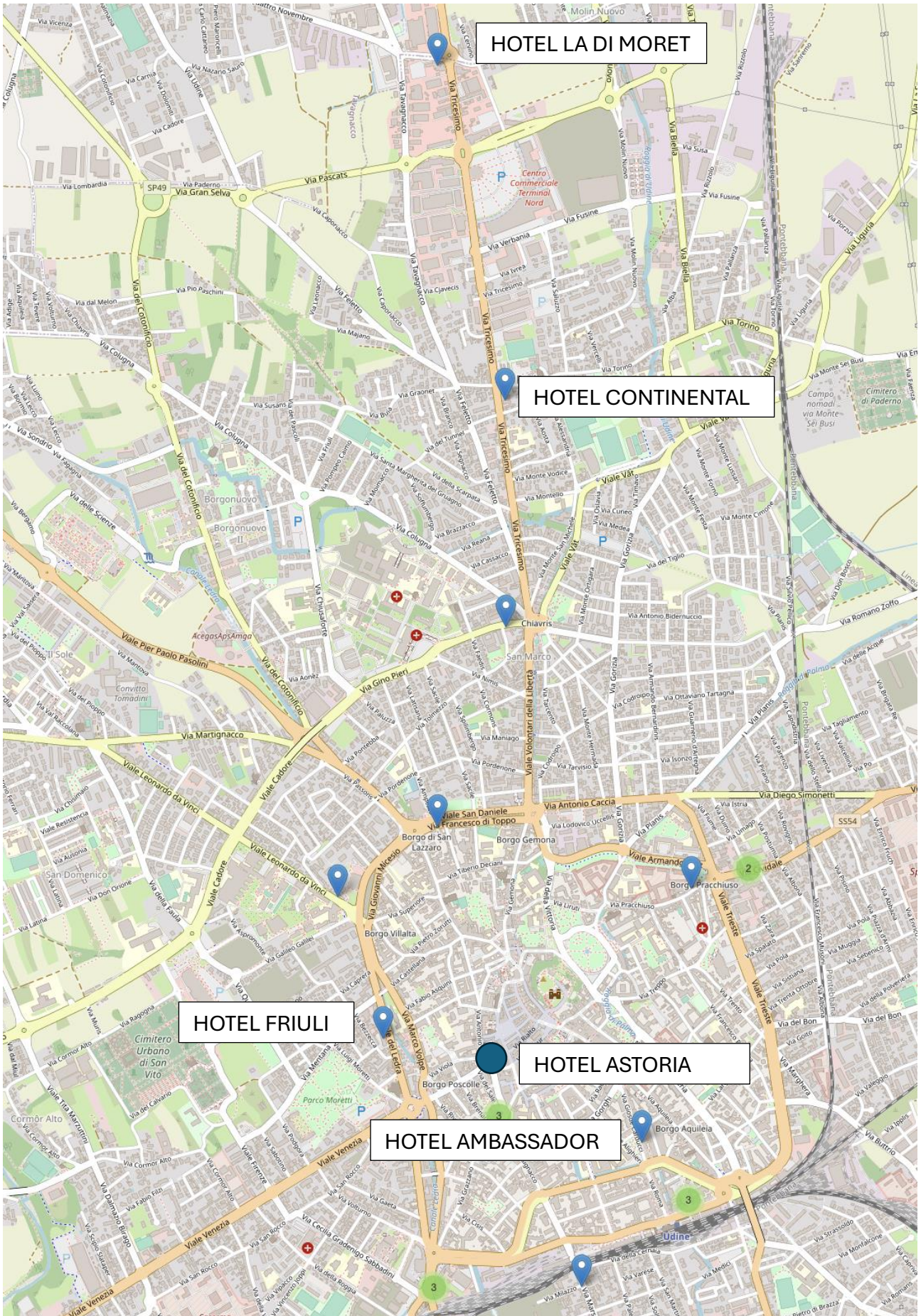

How to reach Udine

Udine lies in the middle of Friuli-Venezia Giulia and can be reached from all directions.

Here's a list of the means of transport and the roads that can be used to reach this beautiful city.

Train

Thanks to good national railway connections, Udine can be reached by train from any Italian and European city through different train operators. If you are coming by plane, you can reach Udine by taking the train from the railway stations of Treviso (90 minutes, 10,60 €) or Venice (about 2 hours, 12,30 €).

- Trenitalia - travels throughout Italy (regional and high speed service)
- Italo - travels throughout Italy but only offers some routes (high speed service)

Plane

Udine is not served by an airport, but is close enough to the airports of Treviso (117km), Venice (121km) and Ronchi dei Legionari (33km). If you land on any of these airports you can take a train, coach, bus or car to take you directly to Udine.

By car:

- From the north (ie Austria) by taking the A23 motorway towards Udine or Venice
- From the west (es Venice) by taking the A4 motorway towards Trieste and then keeping left until the crossroads in Palmanova, following the directions for the E55 motorway towards Udine/Tarvisio/Austria
- From the east (ie Slovenia) by taking the A34 motorway towards Venice/Udine, then following the E55/A23 motorway towards Udine/Tarvisio/Austria
